### **How much is a new kitchen going to cost me?**

The price for a fitted kitchen, whether large or small, can vary considerably, depending on your budget, what appliances are required and the amount of tiling or flooring, etc. involved. Whatever your budget, we believe we have a range of products to meet it.

It generally takes 4 - 6 week to order, inclusive.

### **What is involved in the free planning and design service, and is it 'no obligation'?**

No. Unless it is an integrated fridge designed for the purpose, it will not work, as the heat build up will be too great. However, there is a huge choice of integrated fridges available at very reasonable prices and also integrated dishwashers and washing machines.

### **What height are your kitchen wall units, as I want the maximum storage?**

We have three heights of wall unit to accommodate most ceiling heights and any height customer. They consist of 900mm 720mm & 570mm. The storage in the tallest units is 60% more than the storage in the smallest, but the price is only 30% more.
